ANNEX TO THE ANSWERS TO QUERIES II-1 and VII-2:

When submitting enclosures to replies to queries, **Enclosure to the replies II-1 and VII-2 – FRAMEWORK POSITION OF THE MONUMENT** was communicated to participants by mistake and it is not relevant.

The framework zone of the monument to Stefan Nemanja in terms of position is shown in **Enclosure to the replies II-1, IV-2 and VII-2 (dwg)**, and the orientation and geometric relation of the monument to the building of the railway station and the area of the surrounding space in general, is in accordance with the first solution, as indicated in accompanying documentation with the contest program.

The height of the monument according to the final solution that is in the realization procedure, according to the information provided by the author (19.12.2018) :

The height of the monument "Stefan Nemanja" from the level of stone slabs (sidewalk) to the top of the head is 19 m 20 cm.

The height of the stone slabs (sidewalk) to the end of the sword is 21 m 80 cm.

And 2 m below the level of stone slabs (sidewalk), under the glass.

Certainly, this is a survey competition and it is envisaged that the chosen competition solution of the floor design should be adapted to the needs of specific contents during the elaboration and further phases of development of project documentation.

ANNEX TO THE ANSWER TO QUERIE I/2 :

Pursuant to SPSPABW / 2.3 FLOODPLAINS / 2.4 PUBLIC GREEN AND FREE AREAS:

- *When reconstructing existing and building the new green areas, it is required to provide the appropriate number and arrangement of public toilets;*
- *Public toilets are planned within the Bristol Park (P1), park on the left bank of the Sava River (P4) as well as in two newly planned park areas - Central Park (P2) and Park near the new pedestrian bridge (P3). Within the Bristol Park, the Plan provided the possibility of planning a public toilet also as an underground facility.*
